



- 3. Shop for the items on the list. You do not have to buy everything listed on the tag; these are suggestions.
- 4. Place them in a gift bag and put the tag on the bag so that it doesn't get detached and is visible. Please use a gift bag so we can add any extra items that are donated.
- 5. Return the bags to the church on or before December 7th.

You are welcome to add a Christmas card if you desire. Our veterans ask for very little, please feel free to add items not on the tag. Personal hygiene items, socks, candy and gift cards are always good ideas. Gift cards to Walmart are the best since the stores are everywhere and they can use them for goods, groceries and prescriptions.

You can donate items even if you can't adopt a whole tag or put extra items in a grocery bag marked "Extra".
