Communities in Hidalgo, Mexico, were devastated by Hurricane Priscilla in early October. Torrential rains washed away entire streets and bridges, splitting neighborhoods in half and leaving families isolated without food, shelter, or clean water.

Enciende Una Luz is collecting donations of **non-perishable food** (rice, beans, pasta, flour, sugar, cooking oil, powdered milk), **clothing and shoes** in good condition, **hygiene items** (soap,

toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, feminine products, hand sanitizer), and **basic medical supplies** (bandages, alcohol wipes, first-aid kits). **Financial donations are also welcome** and will be used to purchase food and essential supplies locally in Hidalgo. (They can do venmo and cash app.) They hope to get everything collected by this Sunday, Oct 26. Volunteers will personally travel to Mexico to deliver what is collected.
