Our oldest granddaughter, Daniele, graduated as valedictorian of her class on May 18. In just a few short weeks she's off to Pensacola to prepare for international ministry. Please pray for her and her family.

JILL'S HEALTH UPDATE



After 13 months of "everything is normal" test results we have a diagnosis! A recent double heart cath revealed no significant blockages. Praise the Lord. This leads to the diagnosis of **Coronary Microvascular Disease (CMVD)**. The smallest arteries that feed the heart muscle spasm and do not allow the heart to receive the blood supply needed. As a result she experiences shortness of breath, continuing chest pain, fatigue and weakness. She has been on two heart medications for 7 weeks now that work to keep the arteries dilated so that the heart muscle receives better blood supply. She's already seen a difference. She returns to the cardiologist Aug. 30 for a follow up, instructions, etc., and hopefully a clearance to travel. Please pray that she will be able to tolerate the medications, that she will continue to improve, and that the medications are available in the Philippines.
