We are thankful that we can continue serving the Lord in Mexico and for the “fruit that may abound to your account.” Philippians 4:17b. One example is David who was just a little boy over 30 years ago when we arrived in Juarez. He strayed during his teen years but is now a missionary in Matlapa, Mexico. He recently reported 4 baptized, 3 vacation Bible schools, and the opportunity to preach at a youth camp in Mante. Pray for more young people to respond to the call to full-time service. Juan and Veronica are one such couple who responded to the call, graduated from our Bible Institute, and currently have a weekly Bible club for kids in their very tiny home. We are praying for an open door to start a new work with them in a house which may soon be available.

We have been in Mexico for almost 40 years and have almost always been involved in construction in churches or the Bible Institute. I can no longer do the work physically but I try to help financially. Since we'll be starting a new work, our finances will be limited in helping other projects. Closer to home, the Peniel Baptist Church in Juarez, pictured below, has completed a roof on their Sunday School building and other work on the upper floor (#1) and now need to finish the walls and put a roof on the second floor above the auditorium(#2). Any amount of offering for these projects would be appreciated. The members are working to provide for the finishing work on the inside.



The youth camp this year was held in tents on a property not far from Chihuahua City instead of on our property in the mountains. Where our camp is located is just too dangerous as the rural mountains of western Chihuahua have been the scene of repeated violence as drug-trafficking organizations battle for control of the region. The State Department has issued warnings for downtown Juarez where people are being shot in broad daylight. The violence has been raging in Juárez for months despite increased patrols by state, federal and local police. The number of deaths from January to the middle of August is at 829 with the numbers reaching nearly 200 a month.
