The ministries of the Endasak Baptist Church are going well. FUNERALS

Death is a very common occurrence in our villages here in Tanzania. With no insurance or funeral homes, the responsibility to bury a loved one falls entirely on the

immediate family to oversee the funeral service and burial. The neighborhood and local leadership are responsible for digging the grave, preparing the house for the service and cooking the meal. It is quite the example of cooperation. By God's grace, we have shown ourselves faithful as a church who loves and serves it's neighbors.

Because of this, we often have the opportunity to conduct funeral services and burials for families whose loved ones had no "religion" or were "disobedient" to their respective churches. Also, if a suicide occurs many

churches will not bury the victims. Over the past month, God has opened the door for EBC to conduct three funerals in three different villages. Using Gospel of John booklets as a tool, over 1,250 people heard and read the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This has given us a greater realm to minister and we have seen over 30 people trust Jesus Christ as their Savior. ***Please pray that these opportunities will result in growth in the local church and that those who received Jesus Christ would also begin the follow Him.***
