We added 3 weeks to the time needed for the teaching and traveled to Scotland to visit the Mills, to Ireland to introduce her to her ancestral homeland, through N Wales and around England during free time. It was a blessing to me to be able to do this with her. To see her worshipping our Lord was my greatest blessing! She learned to love the people – especially the pastors, their wives and the people of Temple Baptist Church of Wolverhampton. She and I enjoyed spoiling the young people at the college with a few American dishes. Everything went over well except for the biscuits and sausage gravy. British people are not ready for that Southern dish unless they have been “educated” in Southern cooking over a period of time – as the two who requested it have been. (They had plenty of left overs.)

It seems that I must be accident-prone. Last fall, I dislocated my shoulder while in Peru and this fall I took a tumble down a partial flight of stairs in Ireland.
