Dear Friends & Family,

We have returned to Ecuador for our next term of service. This year will mark our 30th anniversary of being appointed missionaries in Latin America. God has and continues to do amazing things for which we are thankful.

We want to share our final furlough report. Though we were only able to visit about 60% of our supporters, friends, and family, God still encouraged us along the way. We traveled 36,000 plus miles through 18 states, spoke at 46 churches, 6 Awana programs, 5 schools, 3 missionary ladies groups, and a Christian Businessman's Breakfast. We also met with 35 other pastors and church leaders. And most importantly, 12 people trusted Jesus Christ as their Savior!!!!

We are also extremely grateful and humbled by the many people who have prayed and sacrificed for us to return to the field. God has provided 97% of our support, 93% of our ministry vehicle fund, and 45% of our Outfit and Passage.

We have submitted our visa paperwork with the government of Ecuador and are waiting to receive our resident visas. Our visa interview will be in late April, so please be in prayer about that.

Upon our return to Quito, John began immediately to meet with his Persian friend for discipleship. While ordering coffee at the local coffee shop, the Persian man turned to John and said, "I've invited some friends to come today for coffee. Is that alright?" What a blessing to share the Gospel with those who have never heard!
