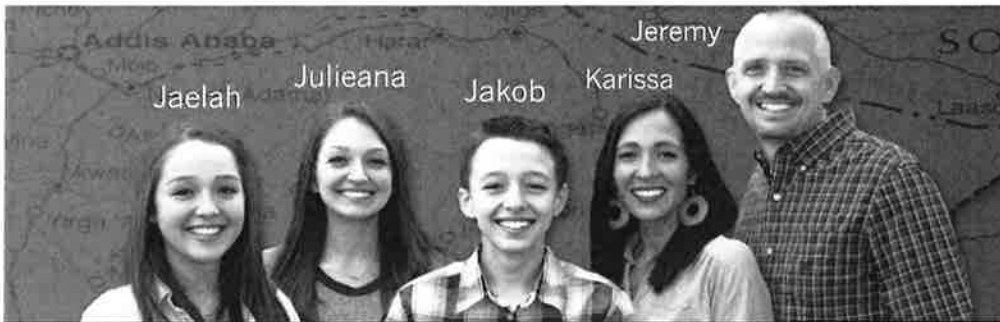

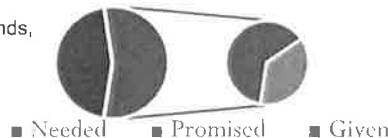


Bible College Update
