Dear Pastor Grieme and friends at Central Baptist Church,

We've had a whirlwind of activities lately. During the summer we had a ten-week English Club in our backyard with more than fifty kids, with about one third of them every day. We had many different topics, games, Nancy and I shared how we came to Ukraine, and I spoke from the book of John. Each student was given a booklet of the Gospel of John/Book of Romans. They know the gospel and we plan to continue working with them next summer.

In September we went to Armenia for Ukraine government paperwork. While we were there Ron preached a couple of times, Nancy played the piano and harmonica, we did some sightseeing, and went near Mt. Ararat where some think the ark landed. Two weeks later we got a surprise when we were in Kiev where Ron was teaching a two-week class on the Bible. One of his students was from Armenia. When Nancy showed him pictures of some of the people there, he knew almost all of them.

We are still working on our residency paperwork, but it seems like everything is going well. Some prayer items:

- our Ukraine resident permits to be finished this month
- plans for another evangelistic Summer English Club in 2019
- one couple or two young ladies to come & teach English for the summer

- our continued health
- a new full-time or part-time Ukrainian helper
