MISSIONS EMPHASIS MONTH



Throughout the month of February we have visited our churches and start up churches to challenge the believers about Missions. Our emphasis has been on the simple statement, *“you are My witnesses...”*. We are seeking to motivate the churches because in March we plan to launch a new church in the Inanda area of Durban. We want all the branches to feel a responsibility to birth this new church.

Brent travelled for the first time since we returned to South Africa, up to UYaya where one of our start up churches is. Thirty-four people crowded into the unfinished house church that we have begun building.

Another section of the building still needs to be built.

We are going to hire some of the women who attend the services to make cement blocks for this construction. This will enable them to earn money to attend our Easter weekend services in Durban, and provide food for their families as well.



We have recently hired a bulldozer to clear our land for the tent revival we are planning for March 22-31 at Inanda.

After the revival meeting, we will also have our Easter services on this site. All of our churches will be coming to be a part of this. **We are hoping to build toilets and a septic tank system before the meetings take place.**

Please be much in prayer for the beginning of this ministry. Through the faithfulness of God’s people we have been able to purchase a new tent, 50 chairs, a generator and a speaker for this new outreach! We are blessed to have a faithful couple, the Shabalalas, already living in the community who will lead this church.

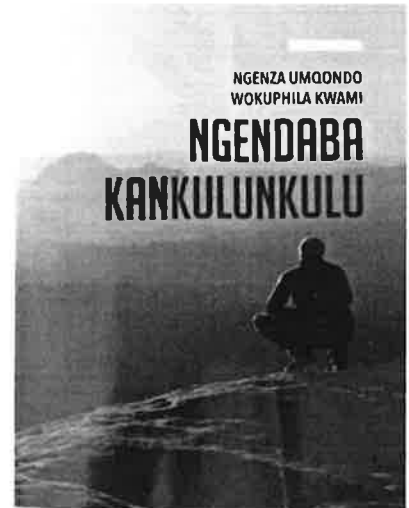


One important tool we are hoping to purchase, not only for the new church plant, but also our other churches is some new gospel literature.

While we were in the States last year, we attended a church who had written a very clear presentation of the gospel. It was in the form of a 7 page fold out tract. We were given permission to translate it into Zulu and other languages in the future. The English translation of the tract reads, "Making Sense Of My Life In God's Story." The picture to the right, is what the copy our leaders translated looks like.

As this is a 7 page fold out on card stock, it is more costly than a typical two fold tract. We have pricing that would give us 500 copies of the tract for about \$230. We hope to get 500 copies for each of our churches, and and then we want 250 copies in English.

Before the tent meeting we will be visiting neighbors in the area to get better acquainted with them, pray for them and invite them to the tent meeting.



SERVICE AT GROUTVILLE

On the last Sunday in February, we held our Missions Emphasis service at Groutville. It was a long, grand service. We are happy to report that an elderly man and three children responded to the message and received Christ.

Keep this little group in your prayers. There is a potential to purchase land with an old house on it for a meeting place. We will keep you posted.

ADDENDUM ON THE UYAYA CHURCH

“Three steps forward and two steps back.”

Brent and Pastor Zulu went to uYaya near the end of February to purchase cement and sand for the blocks to be made for further construction on the building. On the night before their trip, a great wind storm swept through the area. When they arrived they saw a lot of money and man hours lying mangled on the ground!

A number of other people in the area, unfortunately, suffered the same fate.



Facing this crisis, Brent was forced to use undesignated money he was going to be using for other ministry purposes, so materials could be purchased to repair the portion of roof where Pastor Zulu keeps his personal things.
