A REPORT ON OUR MOST RECENT MINISTRY

On March 17, we licensed two of our men to the Gospel ministry.

Paul Shabalala and his family have been a great help to us in both our ministry in Mayville and Amaotana. Now his family is beginning to plant the seeds of a new church in the Inanda area, to the west of us, about a 45 minute drive.

Bongani Ngomezulu has, for the past two years been planting the seeds of a church in the Groutville community to the north of us, also about 45 minutes drive away.



Pray for these men as they continue to minister.

TENT REVIVAL IN INANDA

March 22 - April 21. (bullet phrases from Brent's calendar)

March 22 - Start of the tent revival invitations given out. To our surprise many papers crumpled up and thrown on the ground.

Unknown to us this was a sign of the kind of place God led us to.

The Shembe cult is very strong here as are the Zionist (syncretic) churches and the liberal United Congregational church.

Rain rain go away.... Too much rain on the first night of the planned meeting. Nearly slid hard into fence because of mud on my tires. We will try again Saturday.

March 26 - Very, very slow start. A hard area! Not even children or youth are coming! We have NEVER seen this anywhere we have held a meeting like this.

Our people have been great. They keep coming to help and encourage the Shabalala family.

April 5 - People were protesting in the road with burning tires. Pastors Kubheka and Zulu and the Mayville people unable to make it until an hour and a half late. (A spiritual breakthrough??) Twelve people come forward for prayer to be delivered from their sin and satanic bondage.

April 6 - Two school age boys come to receive Christ as Savior!

The last two weeks before Easter we held services on Wednesday and Friday through Sunday under the tent.

April 10 - Three saved on Wednesday, including a friend brought to the meeting by one of our youth!

One local lady was saved who belongs to a family who all are cult members in the Shembe church.



April 19 - Good Friday morning - our new tent was completely full as our Durban churches, and the children, and care givers from the children's village met together. We needed to add an additional 30 chairs under a 6 m x 3 m pop up tent to give us more seating space.

Friday afternoon - Two young men and five teens spoke on "The seven last sayings of Christ on the cross." Each person had ten minutes. We are so proud of them! Landry also sang a beautiful song called, "The Look".



Friday late afternoon - Baptism back at the church. Fifteen baptized! (Eleven from the children's village with fourteen more candidates from church plants unable to be there.)

Sat. to Mon - Rain, rain rain and more rain! (Sadly, over 80 people killed in flooding in our Province over the long Easter weekend.)

April 21 - Easter Service moved from the tent to our church in Amaotana. We had to delay the church by several hours as Sheila and I went to collect people and items from the tent site.

Seven saved! (A young lady and a school girl who got saved would not have been in attendance had the service been at the tent!)



April 22 - Exhausted!!!

The Shabalala's must be so exhausted from all that they did over the past month. For a solid month they have met every night at the tent for prayer. They have been sleeping at the tent in their car to keep an eye on the equipment. We appreciate their faithfulness.

April 24 -Theft! (Perhaps on Easter Sunday or Monday in spite of much rain) - 2 pop up tents, 2 large amplified speakers, PA mixer, 2 speaker stands, gas stove and gas canister, extension cords, tools.

Fortunately, the generator was having problems and we took it to a mechanic for repairs so it was not taken!

The rains probably provided circumstances where thieves were not detected by the neighbors.

So angry! Yet remembering what the famous divine, Matthew Henry wrote after he was robbed, helps.

"I thank my God that though they stole my purse they did not steal my all. Though they took my goods they did not take my life! And finally, thankful that it is by God's grace, I was stolen from, instead of I who stole!"

Undeterred by this setback, and the hardness of the area, the Shabalala's are meeting for services there on the church property each Sunday. Paul is also faithfully preaching many mornings before school at the local health clinic.



Pray for our upcoming Youth Weekend services June 15 and 16.

Also pray for five Sundays in June and July where we will be having "Friend Days" at each of our churches and church plants.

Sheila and Landry will be heading back to the US on July 23 to get ready for Landry's senior year of High School. Brent will only be able to follow in late August after Will and Dorothy Rogers, who are veteran missionaries, come to relieve us. They will spend 6 months in ministry here to help us out.

Finally, take a look on the next page, at our furlough schedule. We still have open Sundays and weeks should you want us for a meeting or a conference.
