We thank the Lord and everyone who prayed for Nancy. ***Her biopsies came back negative !*** The DR was not sure why Nancy was having these problems, possibly some kind of infection or inflammation, so she started an Herbal treatment that is very similar to the one she has taken before in Kenya. The treatments will be for a few months. Her stomach problem has lessened and she is able to eat now. Thanks for your prayers. God is so faithful through testing!

Last month the Bible Baptist Church of Noonkopir had the conclusion of their Missions month. Jim and Sybil Eberhard shared their burden for Missions and challenged our people to do their part, and watch God work. The Adults and Children had their separate goals. As mentioned before the Adults did well on their promises, but the Children did exceptionally well. Their plan was to give to Missions to be able to help the children of Tanzania. ***Their goal for 2017 was 7600/ Kenyan shillings (\$76), but they gave over 11000/ Kenyan shillings (\$110), about 31 percent higher than the goal.*** The children's act of Faith and Obedience should be an encouragement to us. ***We should always remember that 'Little is Much when God is in it !'***

We are happy to say that Bro. ***Peter Kasamba has received his Entry Permit In Tanzania.*** Now he just has to plan a trip to go to Kenya to get his Family's Passports renewed. Also His Family have all recovered from their sicknesses.

The Lord also blessed a recent safari that Peter took to a remote area in Tanzania where Brother Jeremiah came from. If you remember Jeremiah is a young man that lived near them in Bunju for awhile. He got saved and baptized and then Peter trained him in the Bible School. Well Bro. Jeremiah had gone back to his home area to start a new mission work. For the last 2 months there was no meetings because Bro. Jeremiah fell sick with malaria and pneumonia. Anyway after Peter traveled to see how he was doing, he found him very sick. ***They managed to get Jeremiah to a hospital or clinic and he received treatment and is recovering.*** While there in the area Peter met with the people of the new mission. Also in a nearby community Peter met up with some second generation Kamba people who were in a desperate need of starting a work among themselves. It was blessing to make some initial contacts for a future mission among

them. After returning to Bunju Bro. Peter reports having 4 students in his ongoing Bible School.
