RE-CONNECTING

In November, Jaron was able to reconnect with a young man name Luis that he met back in 2015 at a local gym. Jaron had started Bible studies with guys at several different gyms, but we were encouraged to find out that Luis was from the town of La Concepción. In fact, since 2012 our desire had been to begin a church plant in La Concepción, although, until now it seems God had continued to redirect our steps. Jaron and Luis have now been meeting together and studying through the book of Mark on a regular basis. Will you pray that Luis and his family would be the start of a new church plant in La Concepción?



SET-BACK

Unfortunately, last month, December 14 we experienced a set-back in our plans to begin evangelizing and making contacts in La Concepción. Jaron was on his way to a Bible study with Luis when the back brake on his motorcycle locked up. He was passing a car and was in the lane of oncoming traffic when his brake locked. Faced with the option of colliding head-on with an oncoming truck or dumping the bike into the shoulder, he had to dump the bike. Praise be to God and his grace that the only injury sustained was to Jaron's left lower leg. The accident could have been much worse. However, Jaron did fracture his left fibula and knocked a chip from his tibia through the skin of his left leg. The worst part of the injury was not the fractures but the crushing of the muscle and soft tissue and compartment syndrome in the leg. It has been 6 weeks now and the leg has shown some improvement, although it looks like it will be 6-9 months before his leg is completely healed. Please pray for this situation as our hearts desire is to begin working on the new church plant in La Concepción. While Jaron is doing what he can, including continuing to meet with Luis, he has to keep his leg elevated most of the day and has difficulty walking, which definitely slows our progress. We know that God has a purpose in this and trust that He will help Jaron recover.
