VBS Report

Praise the Lord for His blessings on VBS at Lighthouse (LBC) and Dali Faith Baptist Church (DFBC). After much prayer and discussion, *Space Quest* was chosen as the theme for LBC's VBS. Although some of our past workers were unavailable this time, others stepped up and did an amazing job of preparing, promoting and presenting so the children could see Jesus Christ as the Creator and Savior. There were seventy children in attendance as well as several parents, and two children made clear salvation decisions.



In order to reach more children, VBS at DFBC was once again held at a local park. Being outdoors presented challenges like adapting to the weather and transporting all equipment to the park each time. Of course, the weather is unstable in August and so three of the four Saturdays we faced last minute decisions as storms rumbled through the area. However, except for the last Saturday, which we rescheduled to September, the weather not only cleared just in time, but also brought some relief from the afternoon heat while children gradually came to the park for the *Camp at the Park* themed activity. Being outdoors at the park also meant that some children and parents would only stay for a short time. Nevertheless, it also provided the opportunity for others including older folks in the area to "eavesdrop" on what we were doing. Although no open salvation decisions were made, we are thankful that many heard the gospel and that our workers gained more experience in serving.
