It is exciting to hear the ideas missionaries bring with them but once they begin to knock on doors and walk the streets with gospel tracts, they soon realize that the missionaries who have been on the field for 20,30,40 years have exploited those same ideas. Which brings every missionary to the conclusion, we must get God's word out but God must bring conviction on the hearts of those who hear it. It is for this reason we continue to go to the same villages and sometimes the same people in the village squares with God's Word, knowing that God is not willing that any should perish.

We continue to reach out to those who responded to the N.T distribution. Even though texts and calls have been made to William, it is clear he has shut the door on God's Word; please continue to pray for him. Aaron has recently responded and we continue to send a weekly text or call to keep the door open. We will be inviting Aaron to our Friends Day in May. We have not had any response from Lorna but hope for a response when we go into her village, probably in April-May, do continue to pray for her. Allen has contacted us again, (mentioned back in 2017), he doesn't have transport and lives too far to give him a lift, but ask prayer for him.

Our new tract, *Heaven, does it really exist*, is going out, thus far we have put out 1200 in our neighboring village, Bridge of Weir. Do pray with us as God's Word goes forth into the homes and hands of the Scots, that the Lord will bring conviction with a positive response to receive the Lord as Savior.

We have had a first in the life of May who has lived in this country for 60+ years, we were snowed in for three days, due to a massive snow storm. We do praise the Lord for his provision during that time as we had power, whereas thousands of homes were without power. It was refreshing to reflect on God's goodness then and get a needed rest. We can only rejoice in the Lord to give his servants what they need.

We need your prayers in choosing a new missionary to support. The Wicken's will be leaving their ministry in England and moving to America. Do pray the Lord will direct us to the missionary we are to support. To find one who stands where we stand is difficult here, so your prayers are much appreciated.
