It is truly humbling to be used by God in such an amazing way. Denise and I are often dumbfounded on why He would call a Plumber and a Domestic

Engineer to serve Him on the foreign field in His ministry here in Mallow, Ireland. This quarter we have witnessed first hand God moving, stirring and lighting a revival in our heart as well as the church. In this quarter we have seen 10 people accept Christ as Lord and Savior, 12 surrender to follow the Lord in believer's baptism, 7 reach the halfway point of one-on-one discipleship, 5 complete one-on-one discipleship and 2 have started to disciple another for the very first time. I don't know about you but that just sets my heart ablaze. One of the best problems we have right now is that we have more people that want to be discipled than are available to disciple. It is a true blessing to see the church understand the Great Commission Matthew 28:19-20 and run with it. Please pray that those that have finished discipleship can lead someone to the Lord and start the process of making true followers of the Lord.

**An update on our Prayer request:
As we draw closer to our 5 years in country this
February that means we draw closer to applying for
naturalization or dual-citizenship. Please join us in
prayer that everything will go smoothly and He will
guide every document and every piece of paper**

through with ease. We would love to come back to the US in 2019 to report first hand to you all what the Lord is doing. This would be our first furlough. This process will take all of us praying. Many who serve here and hold a religious workers visa can struggle in the application process. We must also consider the cost as well. It can reach to over a €1,000 = \$1,150 pp to receive naturalization over the age of 18 and nearly €300= \$350 for minors. The plane tickets back to the US may also be well over €1000 pp for our entire family of 6. The cost is staggering. We will be looking at €10,200 or \$12,000 in total, so please pray that God will meet all of our needs financially for this stage of our journey.

We have been personally able to put money towards our need and a church in Virginia has shown interest in helping with the cost possibly with their Christmas missions offering.
