Dear Pastor & Friends:

We trust this letter finds each of you enjoying the blessings of Our Lord. We have many things to report about the work here and around the world.

We have several reports from Vietnam of several there trusting Christ as their Savior and following the Lord in the waters of baptism. One of the new converts the week before he was baptised went through each of the five stories of the place where he lived and destroyed all the the idols that they had been worshipping. His parents were about to visit him and being the oldest son he will surely be punished. Perhaps he would be pronounced dead as a result of turning from the family religion. Some who have been attending Bible studies for over seven years have trusted the Lord as Savior in Taiwan. In Indonesia our missionary is having some real problems with the Muslims there. At least one member was attacked because of their faith. Please pray for Leonel Rafales as he seeks to find another place where they can get permission to have their meetings.

Here in our main work we have been seeing several people getting saved and being baptized. Each Thursday night we have a large group going out soul winning and that is producing much fruit. One Saturday per month we have family visitation where over one hundred come out to go soul winning. I must say that it a huge blessing to see and be a part of. We have passed out over 30,000 tracts in the past six months.

We have seven interns working full time here at our church. Each of these young men have graduated Bible College and are now getting practical experience serving the Lord. One day these men will represent seven new works in places where the Gospel has never been preached, here and around the world.

This November 18th we will celebrate our 40th anniversary as a church. We praise the Lord for one dozen foreign missionaries that are now serving Our Lord directly out of our work here. We thank the Lord for allowing us to start ten mission works here on Leyte and other parts of the Philippines. We are blessed this year with around eighteen Bible College students getting prepared to serve the Lord full time.

Last but not least they are making good progress on our house. We are not really sure when it will be completed yet, but they are moving right along in the work. We still could use some help with the balance we still need to finish this project. If anyone would feel lead to help us with this just marked your gift to the office " House Fund".

As always we thank the Lord for your partnership with us for many years. Your labor is not in vain. The Lord is blessing the work here and around the world. We appreciate each of you so much.

This information just came to me. It should not be long before we can actually start work on the burial site that we are constructing on the end of the property at Camp Victory. It will be the first ever place where those who are not Catholics can be buried.
