Dear Pastor & Friends:

We trust this letter finds each of you enjoying the blessings of Our Lord.

We are having good reports from Taiwan, Vietnam and Indonesia of people that our missionaries have been working with for years that are now coming to know Christ as their Savior. We are somewhat different than the majority we read about. It has been our experience of the past forty years that people come to Christ after many sessions of dealing with them about their eternity. We have never seen the multitudes making professions like we see reported by others. It also has been our experience that it takes more than fifteen years and many times longer to establish just one self supporting local New Testament Church. We rejoice however in the great blessings of Our Lord.

In our last letter we mentioned our monthly family visitation. I am glad to report that it is still going strong with more than one hundred attending each time. Even this past Sunday two high school boys were first time visitors as a result of the Saturday visitation. Several Bible studies have been started that are still going on. Some have come to know Christ and followed the Lord in baptism.

This February 23rd thru 25th is our annual Faith Promise Missions Conference. We are honored to have Pastor Robert Kurtz from Mansfield Baptist Temple to be our first speaker. Brother Joel Basilan our missionary to Taiwan; Brother John Mark Alison and Brother Aries Vera Cruz. All of these men are our missionaries directly out of our church and Bible College. Our theme this year is , " A Church Alive Makes Missions Thrive". I have written a theme song and Brother Niki Diaz has put it to music for us.

In the past five weeks we have seen seven baptized here in the main work. One was a married couple from one of our Bible Studies that had just gotten saved. They took part in their first Lord's Supper this past Sunday.

We are still making improvements in Camp Victory. Our people are giving so we can furnish the first cabin that we have built there.

We have a great group of students that love the Lord in our Bible College once again this year. The future for the Gospel around the world is looking good as these students will go out one day to reach the world for Christ.

I would ask that you would continue to pray about my back situation. It has been almost four months now and still having times of some real bad pain. I am told by many that this is to be expected so I am doing my best to keep going and looking forward to the day when the pain stops.

As always we love each of you that have a part in our lives and the work here and around the world.
