Dear Pastor & Friends:

Greetings in the Precious Name of Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Summer time is upon us here in the Philippines. Since we have only two temperatures here, hot and hotter, this is the hotter one.

Academy and Bible College graduation has taken place. This was our 37th graduation services. We had a great year in both Academy and the Bible College. Two of our Bible College graduates have been lead to do internships here at our church. We welcome Rosalie and Jayson to or staff here. This brings the total of our interns to seven now. Each of these interns have finished Bible College and have plans to serve the Lord full time here or around the world once they get in some practical experience here at Grace Baptist Church.

As stated in previous letters we have fifteen foreign missionaries directly out of our main work here in Tacloban.

We just finished two weeks of camp at Camp Victory. The Camp has had many improvements the past few months. The gym has been painted and the floor. A new kitchen has been added, plus an office, rooms for workers to stay with their own private bathrooms. We have added a platform area for the speaker on the side so that gym floor is all usable now. The grounds and dorms are in great condition now since we have full time couple working and living there from my sons work in Dulag, Leyte. Several were saved at camp this year and a host of others made life time decisions about serving the Lord and bringing Him glory. We have one more week to go which will be our Junior Camp.

Our main work here is being blessed in many ways. Our building is full Sunday morning services and in our Sunday evening services. We have so many new people visiting and have baptized twelve over the past two months. Offerings are really being blessed also.

My wife and I are overdue for a furlough. My wife needs to check in with her doctor who is dealing with her Parkinsons. He needs to see her every so often so he can continue to prescribe her medicines. We will leave the Philippines May 28 and return back here on August 16th. I will be sending everyone on our prayer letter list an up to date video of the work here and around the world in June with our next letter. We have tried to schedule a few meetings while in the U.S. and each of the ten Sundays are just about full.

We are enjoying the house the Lord allowed us to build. It is good to know that the Lord willing we will never have to look for another place to live. We had to borrow some funds to complete the house. It is good to know that in another twelve months that will be paid for and then no more rent. A big thanks to all those who helped us with this project.

The Lord is at work here, and we praise Him for that. We also thank Him for all of you who have been our partners for so many years now. Many have ask me since I am now 72 years old what my plans are. First it is to stay in God's will and bring Him glory. Unless He changes my mind it is to stay here and serve Him as long as we can and die here on the field where He has given us the honor to serve now for forty one years. There is still a lot to do and it is a fact we enjoy serving Him in the place He has called us.

A big thank you to all, we love and appreciate you for your part in our lives and the work here.
