Dear Pastor and Praying Partners,

We began praying back in 2010 for a couple that could eventually be our camp caretaker at Camp Victory. We have prayed and looked for more than 8 years! We are thankful for Pastor Ranilio who oversaw the camp during all those years; but he did not feel led for that to be his ministry. We had no idea how God was working in Bryan and Analyn's lives, the couple in Dulag. Financially, things have been very tight for them for years, living on a mere \$70 a month!! But they have been faithful in giving their tithe and missions ever since they began attending our church in Dulag. Analyn shared with Christi how they were looking to move to find a better job, but really did not want to leave the church in Dulag. We immediately thought of Camp Victory! We sat and talked to them about it and took them to see the camp. They almost immediately accepted and are so excited to have a ministry now. We got them all moved into their new home there just a few weeks ago. They are still able to come to Dulag to be involved in the ministry there, and now Bryan is able to come with us on visitation. Please pray as they continue to adjust to the new place.

Please pray that God would provide the needed funds to finish building a dormitory for our workers/pastors at Camp Victory. Every camp the dorms are almost full, so those workers who come to work in the kitchen, or as counselors, and even the pastors, have no choice but to sleep with all the campers, or set up a tent outside. We have had some already help with this project even before we ever put it in our letter, but we still need about \$4,500 to be able to build this dormitory. This would be divided in the middle and have space for a men's and ladies dormitory with a bathroom on each side. We would love to see this project completed before our summer camps, which start in April, if the Lord would see fit.

We will be coming back for about a six-furlough around August of next year. We will need to raise some additional support as we have had some churches drop us or have had to cut back because of financial reasons or change of leadership, and prices here have really increased in the last several months. If you would like to have us come while we are on furlough, please send us an email, or if you have a pastor that you could recommend that we contact, we would appreciate it. Please pray for Joshua, as he will be staying in the States to attend Bible college. This will be a first for us, leaving one of our children behind! Pray for wisdom as he is praying and seeking where God would have him attend.

Our young adults had a "Master Chef" competition where they were able to display their cooking abilities. They have been divided into 2 teams for the remainder of the year, and every Sunday they are given points for those who memorize verses and bring visitors. We have been having visitors come almost every Sunday and have seen some saved and some being disciplined right now for baptism.

We began passing out tracts and witnessing in a new area of Dulag called Rizal. Ever since the first Saturday we visited there we have had men, ladies and children visit the church from this new area. Pray as we are holding several new Bible studies now in the area with Glenn, Christina, Liza Marie, and Rose Anne. Rose Anne, a young mother there, just trusted Christ last Saturday.
