Dear Pastor and Praying Partners,

"What's on your mind?" was the theme of this year's youth camps. We held the single adults camp the last week of March, and the high school camp two weeks later. We had more than 200 campers in the camps plus workers and counselors. What an applicable theme for our young people today who are bombarded with so many thoughts and temptations with just the click of a button. This year we set camp up a little different. We had a counselor responsible for about 5 campers. They met every morning for devotions; and then after the morning preaching and the evening preaching the counselor met with their group and asked what each learned from the messages. The Lord used this in tremendous ways! With having the one on one interaction several times a day, they really opened up to their counselors and shared very personal things. We saw God save many souls, some received assurance of salvation, several surrendered their lives, and many made decisions to change what was on their minds. We have had 10 baptized already in Tacloban since the camps ended and several of the other churches have baptized young people as well. I wish I could let each one who has invested in Camp Victory see the lives that have been touched already this year in our camps. Thank you for those that gave to have the bunk beds built, the extra beds were a tremendous blessing to have!

In February we held our annual young adult Valentines Party with more than 60 in attendance. Our theme was "Love the Old Way, Love God's Way" with the young adults dressed in vintage attire. We had a catered meal with money that was provided by our church members when we went around Christmas caroling in December. We honored 3 of our dating couples who will be getting married this year, and leaving the single adults class. With being here for more than 20 years as a missionary now, we are seeing the next generation grow up in church and marry Godly Christian young people, and in turn having strong Christian families in the ministry.

In March we ended the school year both in our Christian school and in the Bible college. We had the privilege again of seeing several graduate from Bible college and now go out into full-time ministry. Pray for a couple of them who are doing an internship and then feel the Lord leading them to the mission field.

In our work in Dulag, we went to a new area, Alegre, where Christi was able to lead a young mother named Bernadette to the Lord. She has been open to having Bible studies every Saturday. She has not come to church yet, so pray for her and her growth. We are blessed to see our member, Analyn, come each Saturday with her 4 month old baby in a carrier wanting to be a part of visitation! We celebrated our anniversary in Dulag last month and had over 100 present, with several visitors. Yesterday we were able to be a part of the wedding of John David, our assistant in Dulag, and Jeanny Rose, who has helped us in our home and ministry for more than 7 years. We are excited about continuing to work together with them in Dulag. How exciting it is to mentor these young couples!
