6. Sean proposes a four part concert series to be held in the fall in our sanctuary. The four groups proposed (not yet booked) are Men's gospel quartet Alleluia Quartet, Christian concert pianist Jim Hendrix, jazz combo Rodrigo Villanueva and his friends, and folk/bluegrass group The T Sisters, who have been featured on Prairie Home Companion and opened for several big names including Amos Lee. These concerts will be held every other weekend in the sanctuary, with a gala preceding the event with hors d'oeuvres, desserts, and tasty non-alcoholic beverages. Ticket price will be \$25 with a series package price of \$80 to encourage a sellout of all four concerts. There are between 200-240 seats available and the target sellout is 200 seats. This makes the budget for each concert \$4000. Publicity is roughly estimated to be \$4000 for the series as a whole (which will encourage early sellout for series subscribers). T Sisters booking, lodging, and meals fees will total approximately \$3000. Alleluia Quartet and Band of Brothers will cost less than \$1000. Jim Hendrix will cost \$1000-1500. Rodrigo and Friends will cost up to \$1500. Gala food will cost \$500 or less per event. Shuttle logistics and miscellaneous event costs will be \$500 or less per event. Total budgeted net proceeds from this event are between \$1500-4500. Primary objective of the event is to introduce new folks to our campus and sanctuary. Secondary to that is to use our new sound system for God's glory and the people's entertainment!
