- **1.** Approved:
 - **A. Mission Statement** "Chapel on the Hill is a community church where all people can come to BELIEVE in God, know that they BELONG in the body of Christ, and learn to SERVE through the Spirit"
 - B. Vision Statement "They will know we are Christians by our love"

Pastor's Report

- 1. Great Banquet in Chicago was a much needed retreat
- 2. Heard from 6 Elders that we are frustrated and not having enough fun, therefore we are meeting at the lakeside for a change of pace tonight
- **3.** Elder Meeting Ground Rules to be followed for every meeting to ensure a respectful, successful meeting
- **4.** Pastor's Report provided. Sean has been Very Busy. Please review and comment as necessary

- **5.** All Elders NEED to have a firm grasp and follow the **Seven Marks of Discipleship**, Sean will start a preaching sermon series on The Seven Marks from May 13 to July 1 (8 weeks)
- **6.** Fall Concert Series is being worked on. Please share with Sean any ideas for corporations who may be willing to underwrite a concert or a series. For example: Kunes
- **7.** July 1 Patriotic Service in CAC with picnic following, personal invites to homes in the neighborhood (Carol R). Sean will discuss and plan with Worship Committee
- **8.** New tradition at beginning of Elders meeting = sharing moments when you spoke of the church/Jesus

Finance Update

- Board of Trustees meetings should be held quarterly(these would include the board of Elders plus Tom R. as treasurer) Next Board of Trustees meeting will be August 2018
- 2. The Chapel has 3.5 million in assets to preserve and protect
- **3.** This responsibility falls on 50 giving families, we have the potential to run out of \$ in October, capital expenses may need to be postponed
- 4. Selling of Royal Birkdale property, net \$337K
 - A. \$50K Reserves (we now have \$100K) that's a true blessing
 - **B.** \$50K Outreach Mission Fund (another true blessing)
 - C. \$37K Capital Expense Fund
 - D. \$200K Investment Fund divided equally among Environmental Social & Governance Fund and ETF Balanced Strategy handled by Raymond James Investments (approved by Elders)
 - **E.** \$200K endowment fund is not to be touched, the interest earned will go to Missions (estimated \$8-10K annually)
 - **F.** In case of an emergency, a unanimous Elder vote will enable the \$200K to be used

Safety/Security Policies

1. Located in Sean's office. First priority will be focusing on child safety and an emergency medical response team

Outreach Update

- 1. National Day of Prayer, 275 attended, 19 from the Chapel
- 2. Remind congregation of our prayer chapel, which is open 24/7
 Walworth County pastors know of the availability of our prayer chapel
- **3.** Dennis & Jeff to attend Bridal Expos starting in June in IL to advertise our beautiful campus as a potential wedding location. Need to research what is an appropriate fee to charge for this service. Proposed \$1,250 which would be broken down \$500 Jeff, \$500 Chapel, \$250 music, clean up. The average wedding costs a whopping \$22,000!!
