So many good things are ushered into our lives during the summer months: more freedom, more time with family, more memories made, more relaxation. However, if we aren't careful, we can grow lax in our spiritual lives and take time off from God during the Summer. Let's not do that!

Rather, "Let us hold on to the confession of our hope without wavering, since he who promised is faithful" (Hebrews 10:23).
