A WORD FROM PASTOR LUKE: March 2026

Church family,

Nothing is more sobering than knowing all our sins are laid before the Lord.

Psalm 90:8 states, “You have set our iniquities before You, our secret sins in the light of Your presence.”

Even those sins that we thought were successfully hidden in deep darkness are living in the light before the presence of our God.

Considering this truth, David begs God, “Do not remember the sins of my youth or my acts of rebellion” (Psalm 25:7a). This plea from David resonates deep within our souls. Why? Because we “all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23). We all have those sins. We all have acted foolish – especially in our youth. We all have rebelled against God. We all stand in desperate need of His mercy.

Thus, like David, we beg, “LORD, for the sake of Your name, forgive my iniquity, for it is IMMENSE” (Psalm 25:11). No doubt, our sin is IMMENSE, but thanks be to God, His love and grace are even MORE IMMENSE. Even amidst our sin, God loves us. Romans 5:8 teaches, “But God proves His own love for us in that while we are still sinners, Christ died for us.” God’s heart is for us; not against us. So much so that He did not withhold even His own Son from us.

So, when we become overwhelmed by the enormity of our sin, may we be reminded of the infinitely enormous love of God toward us. He has made a way where there was no way, and the Way’s name is Jesus.
