A WORD FROM PASTOR LUKE: May 2026

Church family,

I am writing this newsletter article the morning after our Encounter Night. What a night! We came into the night prayed up and expectant, and our God did not disappoint. Our God is so very faithful, and He demonstrated His faithfulness amongst our church family last night. To be honest, I am still processing everything from last night. Special night? Yes! But I am convinced it was also a pivotal night in the life of our church family. As I said in the week leading up to Encounter, I believe we are on the precipice of a mighty work of God here at FBC Kosciusko. Like the Israelites staring into the Promised Land, we gaze upon the splendor of the potential future here at FBC Kosciusko.

Which begs the questions: How do we step faithfully into that future? How do we welcome the work God desires to do here at FBC Kosciusko? I believe wholeheartedly that God provided the answer to these questions through the word He gave Kyle last night. If we are to step into this blessed future, then we must commit ourselves to PRAY and OBEY. In a time like this, we can be tempted to overcomplicate things and become discouraged. We see that happen amongst the Israelites in Numbers 14. May it not be true of us. Rather, let's keep it simple. Let's commit ourselves to PRAY and OBEY.

Commit yourself to obey. The Israelites refused to take the next right step. May it not be so for us. May God give each of us the boldness and courage to take the next right step of obedience. Trust Him in your life. Walk in His ways. Don't underestimate the power of simple obedience. God is not calling you to take all these steps at once. Just the next one. What is the next right step for you? As a church family, may we collectively take the next right step. May we be a church that trusts God and takes bold steps of obedience toward the future He desires for us.

Finally, commit yourself to God's Word. I am convinced that last night was the fruit of our commitment to being a People of the Word. Continue in His Word. Hunger for it. Thirst for it. Surrender to it. May we never underestimate the power of His Word. As we align ourselves to God's Word, we posture ourselves to experience God's work. Be a man of the Word. Be a woman of the Word.

In faith, I believe the Heavens will be opened over FBC Kosciusko. I believe the Spirit's anointing will fall upon this place. I believe the Father's approval awaits us here. Believe with me, and may our faith be shown through lives as we commit ourselves to pray and obey.
