# A WORD FROM PASTOR LUKE: October 2025

Church family,

***“For it is not the one commending himself who is approved,  
but the one the Lord commends.”  
2 Corinthians 10:18***

Paul provides the Corinthian church with a reminder that each of us needs to hear. Consistently, we each need to reflect upon how we are evaluating our lives spiritually.

The Holy Spirit through Paul reveals a sly, destructive reality within our lives as humans: pride and self-deception. Each of us when left to our flesh tends to think more highly of ourselves than we should. Also, when left to our flesh, we are master deceivers, and we deceive no one better than we deceive ourselves. So, God reminds us through Paul here in 2 Corinthians 10:18 that it is **His commendation and approval that ultimately matter.**

The verb “commend” means **“to formally or officially praise.”** We as humans who are bent toward pride and self can foolishly gauge our lives upon our own praise. We can justify sinful actions and over-inflate good actions in a desperate, self-deceiving effort to formally and officially praise ourselves. We can live our entire lives intoxicated by the roar of applause never realizing that the deafening roar is coming from our own hands.

But personal praise and commendation are not what we as Christians should long for. Personal praise and commendation are not the barometer by which we gauge our spiritual health and well-being. Rather, **the praise and commendation we seek is that of our God.**

*Are we longing for His approval and commendation ultimately?  
May our ears be attuned to the applause of our God!  
May we seek His approval in everything we do!*
