A WORD FROM PASTOR LUKE: September 2025

Church family,

"Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord."

1 Corinthians 1:31

The church at Corinth had developed divisions. Members of the church had divided over their allegiance to different church leaders (Paul, Apollos, and Peter). Paul adamantly rebukes them for these divisions – acknowledging that only Jesus was crucified for them. Thus, Paul concludes chapter 1 with the above verse, encouraging the Corinthians to boast only in Jesus – not human leaders.

Paul's message to the Corinthians was clear: **Exalt Jesus Over Everything**. These weren't just words from Paul. No, Paul practiced what he preached. His exhortation to exalt Jesus over everything was merely indicative of his physical ministry to them. Paul summarizes his entire ministry to the Corinthian church just a few verses later:

"I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified" (1 Corinthians 2:2).

We can learn much from Paul's ministry and exhortation to the church at Corinth. His message still rings true today. Here at FBC Kosciusko, it is vital that we, too, EXALT JESUS OVER EVERYTHING! Why? Because **JESUS CHANGES EVERYTHING!** Only Jesus can do what God wills to be done in and through our church family.

So may we be a church that keeps our eyes fixed on Jesus – committed to exalting Him over everything. May we LIVE IN His Presence, LIVE BY His Word, LIVE OUT His mission!
