As we learn to listen for God's voice, you will discover that much of the fruit from the 21-day HEARTWalk will be found in the notes you make in your prayer journal of your thoughts and responses during this special time of drawing close to God and hearing from Him. Your heart will be spiritually healthier, ready to respond to God's invitation to join Him and His work in carrying out Graceview's renewed Vision and Mission. The Reflections you record at the end of your journal will provide you with insight for the year ahead and your life. The creation of a new, personal prayer point list will help you to continue drawing close to Him throughout the year.



DAILY HEARTWalk COMPONENTS

Each week focuses on a specific point of preparedness.
Each day you will engage in:

WORSHIP

Sing, read aloud, listen to music! Follow the instructions found in God's Word to "Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise." Psalm 100:4

***Thanksgiving & Praise**

Specific Scriptures are provided in your journal each day in HEARTWalk to use in giving thanks to God, encourage you, and to reflect on God's blessings. You are also encouraged to give God praise for His greatness, for what He has done, and for His character. All Scriptures come from the ESV.

BIBLE READING

Here you will find a collection of Scriptures to read and ponder. Consider what God is saying to you and record those thoughts in the **InSIGHT** response area at the bottom of the Scripture page. Read God's Word to establish a daily prayer foundation. Also, continue with any other reading plan you may be using; hearing God speak by reading His Word builds faith.

PRAYER

There will be three areas of focus for your prayer time:

- **ShowMe Focus** - Ask God to reveal Himself and His will as you read and pray.
- **Altogether Focus** – corporate prayer points for every Graceview participant
- **Personal Prayers** – prayers guided by your personal petitions. You may begin recording those requests on your Daily Prayer List now, adding to it as you go.

WALK-IT-OUT JOURNALING

In the PrayER NOTES, you can record your devotional thoughts and responses. They may pertain to your prayer requests, God's guidance, answers you have received, personal observations or applications, S.P.E.C.'s (Sins to repent from; Promises to believe; Examples to follow; Commands to obey;) whatever you sense God speaking to your heart.

WORSHIP– Follow your own plan to make worship a part of every day.

THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE:

Enter His gates with thanksgiving, and His courts with praise! Give thanks to Him; bless His name! Psalm 100:4

Prayer: Thank God for something for which you are grateful! Praise God for an aspect of His Character or His goodness!

SHOW-ME PRAYERS (Pray daily for 21 Days. Record your thoughts in the **PrayER NOTES** to use at the end.)

READING OF SCRIPTURE: In addition to your own reading plan, meditate on the following verses:

James 4 *Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.*

Psalms 51:1 *Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot my transgressions.*

Hebrews 4:16 *Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.*

WORSHIP– Follow your own plan to make worship a part of every day.

THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE: *Let us come into His presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to Him with songs of praise. For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods. Psalm 95: 1-2.*

Prayer: Thank God for something for which you are grateful! Praise God for an aspect of His Character or His goodness

SHOW-ME PRAYERS (Pray daily for 21 Days. Record your thoughts in the **PrayER NOTES** to use at the end.)

- Help me hear and distinguish Your voice from any other as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.
- Show me the steps of commitment I need to take toward growing in spiritual health and freedom.
- Give me a revelation of Your will and the goals I am to pursue. Show me where I fit into Your vision and missional plan.

READING OF SCRIPTURE: In addition to your own reading plan, meditate on the following verses:

ALTOGETHER PRAYERS

- Pray that we will immediately and decisively respond to follow Christ’s leading, leaving behind anything that would keep us from obeying and following.
- Thank God for our past. Pray for God to give us clear vision for what lies ahead and that we will not let the past keep us from taking steps forward to take hold of God’s revealed mission.
- Pray that we will let go of any evil thoughts, words, actions, anxieties, attitudes, assumptions, feelings, or unbelief that would keep us from honoring God as we pursue His will.
- Pray for God’s impartation of the Spirit’s fruit, wisdom, and provision to accomplish the mission before us.
- Pray for God to reveal and cast down every idol that draws our attention and obedience away from God, that would present a counterfeit to God’s true plan for Graceview.

PrayER NOTES

**Day 2 SCRIPTURES: Prepare for His Presence
by Letting Go and Leaving "It" Behind**



Matthew 4: 18-22 *While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen.¹⁹ And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."²⁰ Immediately they left their nets and followed him.²¹ And going on from there he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them.²² Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.*

Luke 9:57-62 *As they were going along the road, someone said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go."⁵⁸ And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head."⁵⁹ To another he said, "Follow me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father."⁶⁰ And Jesus said to him, "Leave the dead to bury their own dead. But as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God."⁶¹ Yet another said, "I will follow you, Lord, but let me first say farewell to those at my home."⁶² Jesus said to him, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God."*

Philippians 3:13-14 *Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead,¹⁴ I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.*

Philippians 4:6,7 *⁶ do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

Isaiah 42:9 *Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I now declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.*

1 Peter 3:11 *Let him turn away from evil and do good; let him seek peace and pursue it.*

Proverbs 3:7 *Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord, and turn away from evil.*

1 Peter 5:7 *...casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.*

Ezekiel 14:4-6 *Therefore speak to them and say to them, Thus says the Lord God: Any one of the house of Israel who takes his idols into his heart and sets the stumbling block of his iniquity before his face, and yet comes to the prophet, I the Lord will answer him as he comes with the multitude of his idols,⁵ that I may lay hold of the hearts of the house of Israel, who are all estranged from me through their idols.⁶ "Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord God: Repent and turn away from your idols, and turn away your faces from all your abominations.*

THANKSGIVING AND PRAISE: *I wash my hands in innocence and go around Your altar, O LORD, proclaiming thanksgiving aloud, and telling all Your wondrous deeds. Psalm 26: 6-7*

Prayer: Thank God for something for which you are grateful! Praise God for an aspect of His Character or His goodness!

SHOW-ME PRAYERS (Pray daily for 21 Days. Record your thoughts in the **PrayER NOTES** to use at the end.)

- Help me hear and distinguish Your voice from any other as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.
- Show me the steps of commitment I need to take toward growing in spiritual health and freedom.
- Give me a revelation of Your will and the goals I am to pursue. Show me where I fit into Your vision and missional plan.

**Day 3 SCRIPTURES: Prepare for His Presence
by Stepping Forward in Freedom**



John 8:36 ³⁶ *So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.*

Romans 5:18-19 ¹⁸ *Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. ¹⁹ For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous. ²⁰ Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, ²¹ so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

Romans 6: 1-11 *What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? ² By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it? ³ Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴ We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵ For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. ⁶ We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. ⁷ For one who has died has been set free from sin. ⁸ Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹ We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. ¹⁰ For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. ¹¹ So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.*

2 Corinthians 3:17 ¹⁷ *Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.*

Galatians 5:1 *For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.*

Galatians 5:13 ¹³ *For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.*

Galatians 5:18 ¹⁸ *But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.*

Galatians 5:25 ²⁵ *If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.*

Colossians 3:2,3 ² *Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. ³ For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.*

Psalms 1

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; ² but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night.

³ He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers. ⁴ The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away.

⁵ Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; ⁶ for the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.

Matthew 5:2-12. *² And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying:*

³ "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

⁴ "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

⁵ "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

⁶ "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

⁷ "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

⁸ "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

⁹ "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

¹⁰ "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

¹¹ "Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. ¹² Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Prayer: Thank God for something for which you are grateful! Praise God for an aspect of His Character or His goodness!

SHOW-ME PRAYERS (Pray daily for 21 Days. Record your thoughts in the **PrayER NOTES** to use at the end.)

- Help me hear and distinguish Your voice from any other as I meditate on Your Word and Pray.
- Show me the steps of commitment I need to take toward growing in spiritual health and freedom.

ALTOGETHER PRAYERS

PrayER NOTES

**Day 5 SCRIPTURES: Prepare for His Presence Through
the Gifting of the Spirit**



1 Corinthians 12:4-11 ⁴ Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; ⁶ and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸ For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ¹¹ All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

1 Corinthians 14:1 Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy.

1 Corinthians 14:4-5 ⁴ The one who speaks in a tongue builds up himself, but the one who prophesies builds up the church. ⁵ Now I want you all to speak in tongues, but even more to prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be built up.

1 Corinthians 14:12-15 ¹² So with yourselves, since you are eager for manifestations of the Spirit, strive to excel in building up the church. ¹³ Therefore, one who speaks in a tongue should pray that he may interpret. ¹⁴ For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays but my mind is unfruitful. ¹⁵ What am I to do? I will pray with my spirit, but I will pray with my mind also; I will sing praise with my spirit, but I will sing with my mind also.

1 Corinthians 14:18-19 ¹⁸ I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you. ¹⁹ Nevertheless, in church I would rather speak five words with my mind in order to instruct others, than ten thousand words in a tongue.

1 Corinthians 14:26 ²⁶ What then, brothers? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.

1 Corinthians 14:32 ³² and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets. ³³ For God is not a God of confusion but of peace.
