Enter the Power Zone

How can we enter the power zone in our giving?

- 1. The answer involves the tithe.
- 2.I do not tithe because "I have to" but because "I want to."
 2 Cor. 9:6-8

Four ways tithing empowers us:

- Tithing expresses our loyalty and commitment to God.
 Malachi 3:6-12
- Tithing lets us experience greater financial protection and blessing.
 Malachi 3:9-12
- 3. Tithing exposes the doubt, fear, and greed which tempt our hearts.

 Luke 12:15
- 4. Tithing explodes our ministry impact.

SMALL GROUPS

Introduction

- 1. Go around and have each person share two numbers: how much you make a year and how much you give. Just Kidding! Have one person pray for your group.
- 2. Today's small group is a discussion about tithing. Whether you give a full ten percent or not, let us encourage you to just be open to what God is saying to you through your group discussion.

Book Discussion

- 1. Spend a few minutes discussing any insights or questions you have from chapter 2 of Rich Toward God.
- 2. On page 32, Hood says, "The real issue is not about 10 percent; it's about managing the entire one hundred percent." Talk about this statement.
- 3. After you have worked through the Sermon Interaction section and as time allows consider the questions on page 41 of the book.

Sermon Interaction

- 1. We have all given sometimes out of obligation and sometimes because we wanted to give. What difference does the motivation make in the act of giving? Does it matter? Nathan said that, "the pattern Jesus put in place suggests that giving will precede thankfulness."
- 2. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8. What do these verses say about the connection between our heart and giving?
- 3. For each of the four ways tithing empowers us, talk about how you have seen this occur.
- 4. What is an expression of commitment and loyalty in your life? What is a sacrifice that you make on a regular basis because you are committed and loyal to yourself, to someone else or to God (eg. Waking up early to go to the gym, listening to others when you have somewhere to be, spending time in prayer and Bible study)?
