2. This "Vs." series is going to cover battles between different leadership styles. When have you experienced good leadership and what did it look like?

3. The Bible has a lot to say about pride. Read the following verses and have the reader put it into their own words: Galatians 6:1-4; Isaiah 2:12, James 4:6-10; Philippians 2:3; Proverbs 13:10; 16:19; 18:3; 21:4; 26:12; Romans 12:3, 16

4. Read Exodus 7:14. Now read the verse filling in the blanks for yourself.

5. Use these questions and talk through your answers.

- How is my hubris? How is my pride and dangerous overconfidence? Is it in check or is it ruining my life? Am I the type person who others want to follow because I am self-aware and always learning and always growing or am I full of pride?
- Am I listening to the voice of God? Do I hear what God is saying when he calls me to do things? Or do we assume that pieces of Scripture don't apply to me?
- Do I have a Jethro? Is there someone whose voice I listen to? Or are there people around me who give me advice that I ignore?
