Thanksgiving Crossword



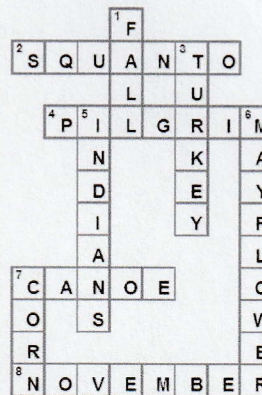
Across
