

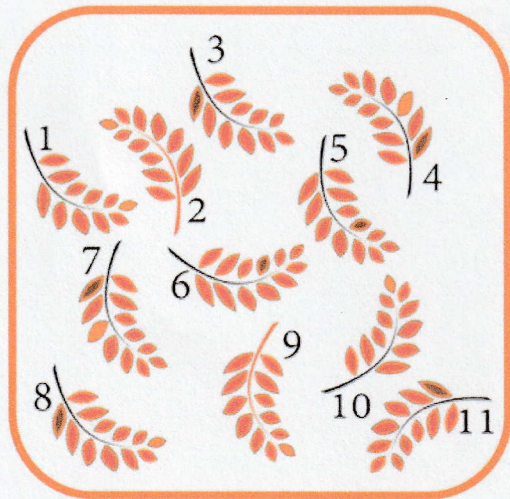
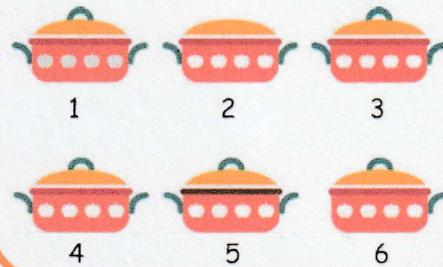
Thanksgiving Fun
