





## PEOPLE PRAYED FOR PETER

**ACTS 12:5-19**

**BIBLE VERSE:** James 5:16

**LIFE POINT:** God wants people to pray for one another.

The people of the church had gathered at the home of Mary, the mother of John Mark, to pray for Peter. He was in prison and Herod planned to kill him the next day.

Meanwhile, Peter was chained between two guards with two more guards standing at the door of the prison. While he was sleeping, he felt an angel wake him. Then he saw a bright light in the prison cell.

The angel told Peter to get up, get dressed, and follow him. Even though Peter thought he was dreaming, he did as the angel said. They went past the first and second set of guards and came to the iron gate to the city. They went another block into the town, and the angel left him.

He went to Mary's home. A servant named Rhoda answered. She was so excited that she didn't even open the gate but ran inside to tell everyone.

They thought she was seeing Peter's ghost. When Peter kept knocking, they opened the gate and were amazed to see him standing there.

He told them what had happened and then left for a different place.

The next morning, there was much confusion among the guards while they looked for Peter.

They couldn't find him anywhere!
