Four of the books were written to reveal God's mind on social, spiritual and political issues. The fifth, Jonah, portrays a prophet's personal struggle with God's call upon him.

The historical background suggests the time frame to be 835 BC to 700 BC. First, Syria and Israel invade Judah then Israel falls to Assyria, Assyria invades Judah and then Assyria falls to Babylonia and lastly, Judah falls to Babylonia.

Men' s groups: Thursday mornings at 6:30am in the prayer room. This group is facilitated by Clyde Vasey.

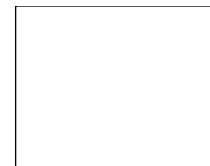
