Parent/Child Dedication

When should Parent/Child dedication happen?

Any age is a good time to dedicate your child(ren). Most often it happens from ages 0-2.

Why Dedicate?

Dedication is an act performed by our Pastors that speaks to the Parents' desire to raise up their child in a godly home, where they are also involved in church. This does not grant your child eternal life. It is a public declaration made by parents about their children. The Bible tells us that we are called to raise up our children to follow the Lord (Psalm 78:4). Samuel was dedicated to the Lord by his mother, as 1 Samuel 1:27-28 says, "I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of Him. So now I give him to the Lord. For his whole life he will be given to the Lord." Jesus was also dedicated by Joseph and Mary in the temple in Luke 2:22-35.

Who should be involved?

Parents and their child(ren).

Whom should I contact if we want to dedicate our child?

Ideas:

- Meet with one of the Pastors in our church to find out if you are ready to do a parent/child dedication.
- Pray over your child every day.
- When? Before heading out the door for work, school, meals or bedtime.
- Find trusted families or adults in our church that would like to intentionally support your decision to dedicate your child.
