COURAGE TO CHANGE

Members of Courage to Change had the opportunity to attend two workshops this week. September 22 from 9:00-2:30, six of our members attended the "How Churches Deal With Addiction" sponsored by the Center For Church Care at Ohio Valley University. Chad Loveless from Nashville Tennessee was the speaker. Chad talked about his experience growing up in the Church of Christ and how poor decisions lead him to alcohol, drug addiction and jail. He spoke about how we as Christians respond to addiction by mostly ignoring it or shaming rather than having a plan in place to deal with the problem.

Wednesday, September 26 from 9:30-4:30 four of our Courage to Change members attended the Motivating Recovery workshop at the South Parkersburg Baptist Church. Sky Kershner MSW, Dmin was the presenter. He introduced several role play activities to help demonstrate the way to more effectively communicate to our loved ones who are alcoholics and or drug addicts. The main thing is to listen and resist trying to fix the person and the problem. The formula is to ask five open ended questions and after each question Reflect-Reflect-Affirm and Summarize.
