February food stamps were issued early and this is requiring families to go at least two months until new monies are given. This budgeting places a burden on those who are already food insecure. We have people come to the pantry who have not eaten all day and are very hungry.</i></p> <p><i>LIA is continuing to address needs in the community with your help. Two baskets of housekeeping items were donated to the Homeless Coalition. The baskets are filled with essentials needed when the Coalition is able to move a person off the street into an apartment. With your generosity, LIA has also been able to pay partial rent, gas shutoff fees and assist with medical bills for those in need.</i></p> <p><i>In an attempt to support our seniors, LIA is opening an onsite food pantry in the Putnam Howe Village Senior Apartments. We have agreed to partner with the Belpre Chamber of Commerce by preparing and serving meals for their quarterly meetings, which will now be held in our building. All funds raised from these meetings will be used for our kids program. Katrina's Kids currently is providing weekly bags of food and snacks to about 60 children for weekends when they do not have access to free food. Your generous giving is also providing food every other month for a community meal at 13th and Latrobe Street Mission. LIA has recently received two grants totaling \$4,400 that will be spent on food purchased from the America Food Bank in Logan. Thank you to all the LIA volunteers and for volunteers at Belpre Area Ministries this past week. Your service to our community is greatly appreciated.</i></p>

COURAGE TO CHANGE

Again in 2019 from January to March, Courage to Change is cooperating with Dominique Dye from the Prosecuting Attorney's office and the Mid-Ohio Valley (MOV) Combatting Addiction With Grace organization in the Project: Get Clean. The purpose is to aid in fighting the drug epidemic by providing recovering addicts with toiletries to get clean, while they are getting clean at an In-patient treatment facility. Courage To Change is collecting the following items: shower caddies, shampoo and conditioner, toothbrushes (medium or soft), toothpaste, deodorant, lotion, bar soap, flip flops, also notebooks, pens, and binders, NO perfumes, make-up, or hair dye. These items will go to people coming from incarceration to an in-patient recovery facility. There is a box on the table by the office entrance. We will be collecting these items until March. Please help our group help those get clean while they are getting clean from drugs. Thank you.
