<b>COURAGE TO CHANGE</b> Wes Crum Ph.D., a member of the Belpre church family and a professor at Ohio Valley University was the guest speaker for the Courage to Change meeting Thursday July 20 <sup>th</sup> . Dr. Crum spoke about the science of Anxiety. He said moderate stress and moder- ate anxiety are good and healthy, however, too little stress or too much stress and anxiety are detrimental to us both physically and mentally. Wes said 7 out of 10 medical visits are related to stress for example, panic attacks mimic a heart attack, however, 20 minutes after arriving at the hospital the symptoms are gone but it is more socially acceptable to see a medical doctor than a thera- pist or psychiatrist. However, a medical doctor can only treat with medication which in many cases leads to prescription medication dependency. Wes gave some simple exercises that anyone can do to relieve anxiety and stress. He demonstrated the 4 square breathing technic and the positive talk. He said you can't be anxious and relaxed at the same time. He said "I am only in con- trol of what <u>1</u> think say or do. I cannot control what others think			<ul> <li>will choose love next.
