COURAGE TO CHANGE

Keith Penn was the guest speaker for the Courage to Change meeting Thurs., Mar. 22. Keith grew up in the Washington D.C. area. He and his family were members of the Apostolic Church and very active in the Church. Keith became a member of the church at a young age and was preaching to large audiences as a teenager. Then he was employed as an electrician, was making good money at preaching and remodeling apartments. He was able to not only pay his bills, but could pay them 3 months in advance. He then went down a path of alcohol and marijuana and though he never became a dealer, he was partying and smoking marijuana to the point he wanted to die. As he was walking his dog in an abandoned mall area he contemplated ending his life. He got the message "I want you to live for me." He went back to the church that had excommunicated him for his reckless behavior and asked for prayer. He met a visiting Bishop from Wyoming and went to live and work there for four years. Working for \$6.00 an hour roofing and doing construction to help the church there keep from going bankrupt. He realized he had been preaching for the wrong reason in the past. That he would get "high" on the compliments, so it was about him and not about God. He returned to West Virginia where his other grandfather had lived. He met a woman, who is a nurse, they married and attend the Lynn Street Church of Christ. Keith is very passionate about his relationship with God and Christ. He has a love for people and a desire to help others by telling his story.
