Janice Farnsworth did a great job at the Courage to Change meeting Thursday May 17. She told her story of how a child from a dysfunctional family with an alcoholic father who was violent and abusive to her mother became an advocate for men and women who wish to recover from alcohol and or drug addiction. Janice left home at age 18 to find a better life only to find herself in worse circumstances after marrying an alcoholic husband who threatened her physically. When she tried to escape from the life of torment and flee to Florida he would find her through tracking the children's school records. After finally being able to obtain a quick divorce in West Virginia she was able to get a degree in cosmetology and open a business. Janice has received recognition in two Who's Who for women, a recognition for her poetry and among other awards an award for grandmother of the year in West Virginia. Janice is an inspiration for those who are in dysfunctional families and or abusive relationships. She has dedicated her life to helping those with addiction. She is a member of the Lynn Street Church of Christ and co-leader of the Celebrate Recovery Program.

LOVE IN ACTION

We continue to try to bless others lives and have made donations to a Christian in Honduras to better her life. We have also contributed towels and wash clothes for ten OVU international students this fall and made a contribution to Women's Care. John Ortherg states, "People would rather debate doctrine, beliefs, traditions, or interpretation than actually do what Jesus said. We just need to do it! Practice loving a difficult person or try forgiving someone. Give away some money. Tell someone thank you. Encourage a friend or bless an enemy. Say "I am sorry!" Plain and simple just worship God.
