Teaching Text:

Ephesians 6:1-4

¹“Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ²“Honor your father and mother” (this is the first commandment with a promise),³“that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land.”⁴Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Heidelberg Catechism

Leader: How are (the ten) commandments divided?
