## The Great Thanksgiving Epiphany 2, Year B

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.** Lift up your hearts. We **lift them to the Lord.** Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. **It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

Summoning God, we thank and praise you because over and over again you call your people to hear your voice and entrust our lives to you.

You make a temple of encounter in our bodies and a tent of meeting in the body of your Son.

You sing to us through the Law and the Prophets, and when we close our ears, you speak through a little child.

Should we find the voice or the timing or the place of your vocation too strange to understand, you bid us simply to come and see.

And so with heaven open and angels and archangels ascending and descending around your throne, we join the song of your eternal glory.

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might. Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

Holy God, in baptism you have made our bodies parts of your Son's body.

In his death we have died with him, and in his resurrection you have given us the freedom of the glory of your children.

Take the brokenness of our flesh, and through the power of your Spirit make your church a temple of your living presence and a crucible of encounter and reconciliation with you.

Send your Holy Spirit upon this bread and wine that they may be for us the body and blood of your Son Jesus Christ; who, at supper with his disciples, took bread, gave you thanks, broke the bread, and gave it to them, saying,

Again he gave you thanks, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Drink this, all of you: this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.
