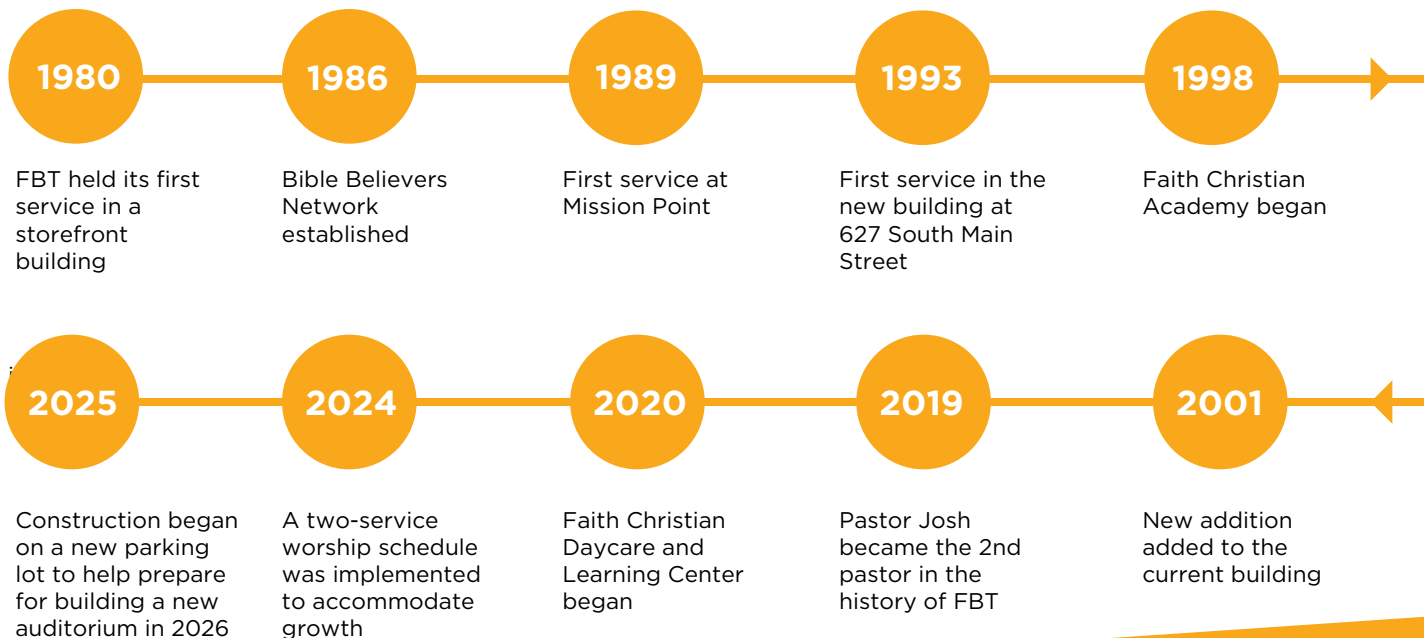

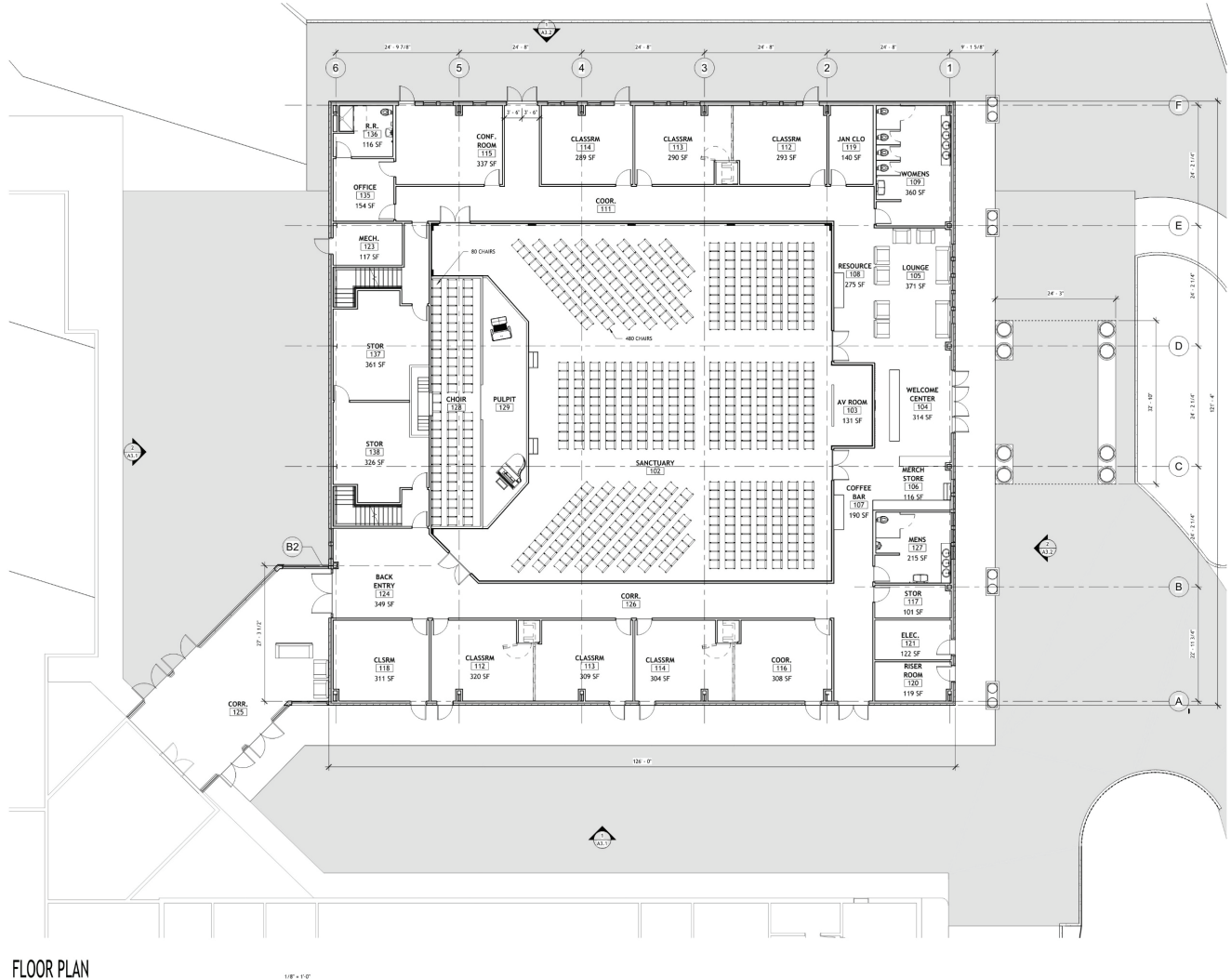

HOW DO I DETERMINE WHAT TO GIVE?

“

Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

2 Corinthians 9:7

1. ASK

Ask God what He wants you to give. This is a question to ask in your own heart and also to be in prayer about with a spouse or your family. The answer is the not the same for everyone.

2 Corinthians 8:12 *For if there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not.*

2. CONSIDER

Consider what you can do or give up in order to be part of this project. Look at the *Chart of Gifts* attached to the left. You can see that it is not equal gifts that will get us to our goals—it is equal sacrifice.

2 Samuel 24:24 *...neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the Lord my God of that which doth cost me nothing...*

3. DETERMINE

Determine your gift and fill out a commitment card. On our Commitment Sunday on *March 1*, we will collect the cards. Then on *March 15*, we will celebrate together what God has done through us.

2 Corinthians 9:8 *And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:*

4. PRAY

Pray that God will give you peace as you begin giving. Remind Him of His promises to those who are generous, and look for how He will keep the promise in your own life.

Philippians 4:6-7,19 *Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*



FAQ

► ***Why are we involved in a stewardship campaign?***

Our future development campaign is an opportunity for us to pray with one another and encourage each other as we consider our individual involvement in the commitment of our treasures for the future of our church. The finances committed will enable us to construct our new facility.

► ***When and how will these financial commitments be made?***

Commitment Sunday will be March 1, 2026. Your commitment will be treated as personal and confidential. If you are not able to be there on March 1, your card may be turned into the offering or church office before that day to be included in the total.

► ***Will I be asked for a commitment publicly?***

No, your commitment is a private matter between you and the Lord. We will not make these commitments a matter of public knowledge in any way, shape, or form.

► ***What if I fall behind on my commitment?***

Commitments are a spiritual step of faith between you and God. If someone is unable to fulfill their commitment, they will not be contacted by the church. We trust that each person that attends FBT will pray and make a sincere commitment, and do their very best to fulfill it. These commitments are given for us to be able to plan wisely.

► ***How much should I give?***

This is not a one-size-fits-all proposition. Each person should be uniquely led by the Spirit. We encourage you to ask God for guidance, and then joyfully obey His lead. The goal is not equal giving, but rather an equal spirit of sacrificial worship.

► ***Can we make one commitment for our entire family?***

Yes, you may. However, we encourage those with children to involve them in some way either through individual commitments or by their partnership in the family's giving.

► ***Will God help me make a commitment that right now seems beyond my means?***

Making a commitment that you know for certain is unrealistic might be detrimental to you and the church. However, sometimes, things that seem beyond reach are actually closer than they appear. Priorities may need to be rearranged in order to participate at a sacrificial level.

► ***Why does my commitment need to be in writing?***

The total amount of commitments are carefully analyzed to forecast future income and to establish a realistic construction budget and timetable.

► ***May I give assets other than cash?***

Yes, there may be tax advantages for you and the church by giving assets (property, stocks, bonds, etc). One of the members of our Finance Committee will be happy to discuss this with you, or you may contact your own personal tax advisor.

► ***May I revise my commitment?***

Certainly. Since this is a commitment between you and the Lord, you may revise it. However, it would be helpful if this was communicated to the church treasurer so that the appropriate adjustments can be made to our income forecasting.

► ***Can I divide my present giving between the General Fund or Faith Promise Fund and the Building Campaign?***

We encourage you to make your commitment over and above any other giving to the church. The current ministries and missions work that we have committed to also need to continue to be funded.

► ***When do the commitments begin?***

Bringing in our commitments will begin on Celebration Sunday, March 15. People may elect to give their commitment on a weekly, monthly, or annual basis. We recognize that the timing of when people receive their income varies, therefore you may begin honoring your commitment with whatever best matches your income schedule.

► ***Can I automate the fulfillment of my commitment?***

For those choosing to give their commitment on a weekly or monthly basis over the 2 year period, automated online giving is a convenient and effective method for bringing that commitment in. You can give through the church website (faithjamestown.org) by selecting the "Building Fund" from the dropdown menu.
