Vs. 19: **They have become callous** and have given themselves up to sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity.

Matthew 13:15: For this people's heart has grown dull, and with their ears they can barely hear, and their eyes they have closed, lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears and understand with their heart and turn, and I would heal them.'

Jeremiah 17:9: The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?

Vs.:20-21: But that is not the way you learned Christ!— assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus,

John 17:3: And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.

Vs. 22-24: to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.

John 3:3: Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Romans 12:2: Do not be conformed to this world, but be **transformed** by the **renewal of your mind**, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Vs. 24: and to **put on the new self**, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.
