

What will Church look like?

Reservations: We will be asking everyone who desires to attend the church services to make a reservation through email. We will send out this email each Monday at 10am. This will allow us the ability to have as many people safely sitting in the Sanctuary according to the State's guidelines on the amount of people who can safely gather together. If we have more people sign-up for the Sanctuary than what is allowed, then we will use the Social Hall as an overflow location. Those in the Social Hall would watch the service on the screen via Facebook Live.

Sanitize: We have a team that will sanitize the sanctuary and the restrooms after each worship service. Sanitizing stations will be placed at the entrances to the church. We will have one person during the service to help clean the restrooms. We are supplied with professional grade cleaning supplies from Paper Chemical in Savannah for this task.

Nursery & Children's Church: At this time there will be no in person Nursery or Children's Church. We are developing our plan for how and when these ministry areas will resume at a later date.

Sunday School & Bible Studies: At this time there will be no in person Sunday School or Bible Studies. We are developing our plan for when to restart these ministry areas at a later date.

Greeting Time: There will be no physical contact for the greeting time. We will look for fun ways to say hi to one another without touch.

Offering: There will be no passing of the offering plate. We will have boxes for people to place their offering at the front or back of the church as they leave the service.

Bulletin: We will email the bulletin to the church family on the Thursday before the service.

Ushers: We will use the ushers to help seat people inside the sanctuary like at a wedding. Further, they will help guide people out of the church row by row at the end of the service.

Baptism – Baptisms will be scheduled with the Pastor to set up a date and procedure that the family is comfortable with.

Communion – We are offering a Drive Thru communion once a month at the church. We have one person who safely will prepare the communion elements. We have a team that will safely pass out the communion to each vehicle. The Pastor will bless and pray over everyone in each vehicle. Another way we will offer communion during in person worship services is through disposable prefilled communion cups.

Children and Youth Ministry: These ministries are working through plans for when to restart in person. We will follow the social distancing guidelines when these groups begin to meet again. For Children's Ministry, we plan on doing more family events in which children attend with a parent or guardian.

Conclusion: We will continue to be flexible and adapt this plan according to the guidelines set by Federal, State, Local and South Georgia Conference UMC Leadership. Please join us in pray as we seek the blessing of the Holy Spirit upon our church family and church min-

Springfield UMC Church Plan

Plan to resume worship services on Sunday, June 28, 2020

Services – Seating – Singing

We will have an 8:00am outside worship service and a 9:30am & 11am inside worship service with people spread out 6 feet apart with household seating. All worship services will be Family Style. Children will stay with their family throughout the whole services. Services will be 45 minutes in length. There will not be a nursery or children's church at this time.

8:00am Worship – This will be a Praise and Worship service outside under the oak trees. **There will be congregational singing. Since we will be outside, congregational singing is considered safe to do at a same distance. Masks will be optional.** Those attending are asked to bring their own chairs to the service. Seating will be by households and six feet apart. We encourage everyone to wear casual attire and feel free to bring drinks with you.

9:30am Worship – This service will be a Praise and Worship service inside the Sanctuary. **There will be no congregational singing following the recommendations from the South GA UMC Conference Leadership Team.** We will have vocalists from the Praise Band helping with our worship service. **Masks will be required for this service.** We have members of our church family who are ready to come back to worship and would feel more comfortable in a service where everyone is wearing a mask.

11:00am Worship – This service will be a Traditional service inside the Sanctuary. **There will be no congregational singing following the recommendations from the South GA UMC Conference Leadership Team.** We will have vocalists to lead the worship as well as bringing special music. **Masks will be optional.**

We will continue to offer online worship services and online Sunday School.

All inside worship services will not have congregational singing or a choir due to safety concerns. We will offer soloists for special music and a congregational leader for music who will be 12 feet apart.

All services will have social distancing 6 feet apart for seating. Seating will be by households. Social distancing will be practiced as well when it comes to talking in the parking lot or walking to vehicles.

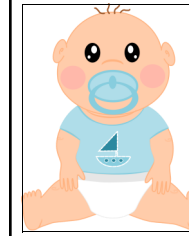
