From January's ALT Meeting:

Selection of a contractor to complete building repairs due to the burst water pipe was discussed; Cruce Brothers Builders were selected to complete the work.

The year-end budget surplus was reviewed; the decision on how to best utilize the surplus was tabled, pending further information on the full scope of repairs required as a result of the pipe rupture.

ALT subcommittees were assigned and new Pastoral Ministry Support teams for properties and benevolence were discussed.

Mature Certificates of Deposit were discussed; bids for renewal rates were reviewed and all agreed to leave the CD's with The Citizen's Bank, which offered the best interest rate.
