### story behind the new stage design

For centuries, musical composers have employed a form called, “theme and variation.” It begins with a theme that is the main melody and is followed by one or more variations of that melody (such as W. A. Mozart’s “12 Variations in C Major ‘Ah vous dirai-je, Maman’ K.265 also known as “Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star”).

In this case, the starting “melody” was the stained glass window above the stage. Its round shape is surrounded by a border resembling the cross. Those shapes were repeated to create the three columns you see on stage. Together they represent God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
