### safe harbor

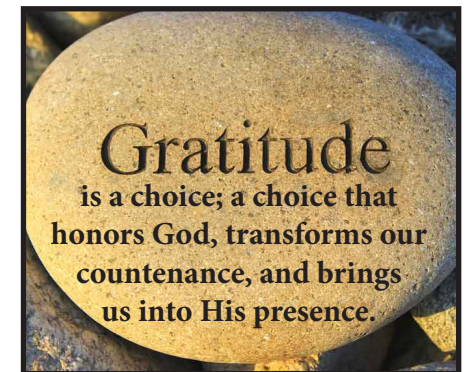
