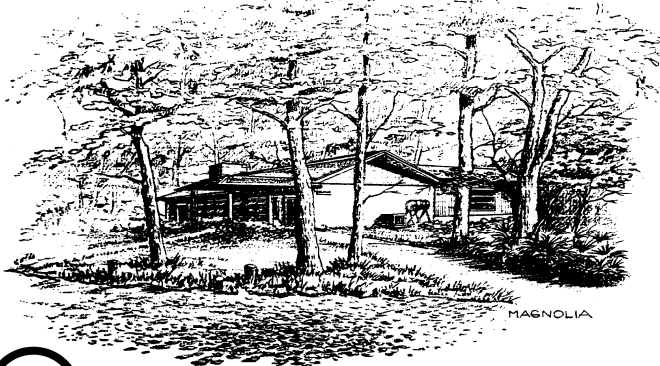


# Lakewood Retreat 2019 Price Schedule

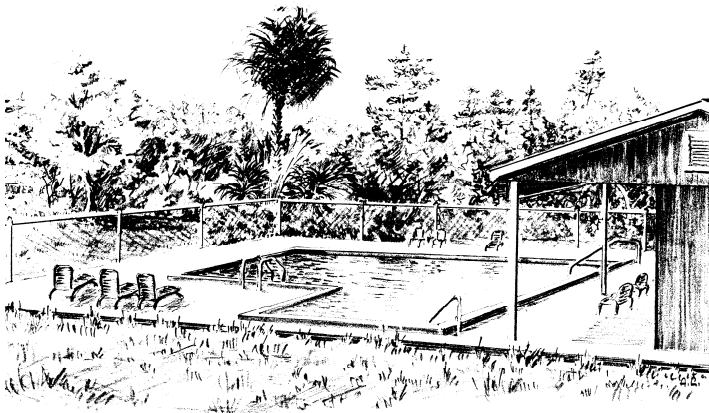

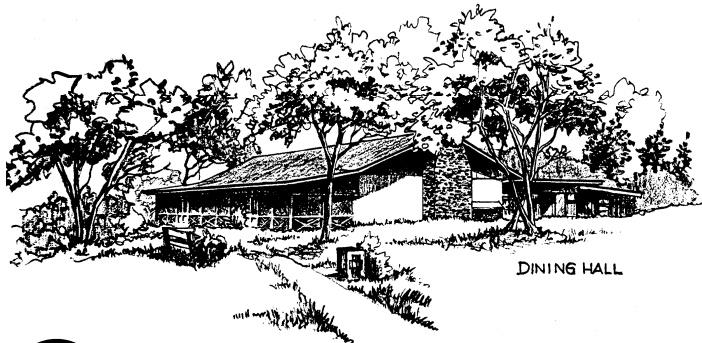

## Special Activity Rates

Most activities such as the swimming pool and human foosball are included as part of the Facility Use rates. However, some of the popular activities require extra preparation or staffing, and therefore incur an extra cost.

<b>Open Fire Popcorn</b>	\$38.00 for 1st kettle each kettle serves to 25 people \$16.00 Add'l kettles
<b>Ice Cream Social</b>	\$3.75 per person 10 people and up, you add the toppings
<b>Hay Ride</b>	\$42.00 per ride each 30 minute ride seats up to 25
<b>Initiative Task Course</b>	\$5.50 per person 8-15 people for a 1½ hour session
<b>Archery</b>	\$18.00 Equipment set-up for 1 hour group use
<b>Pool Exclusive Use*</b>	\$32.00 1 hr exclusive pool use (min 30 people) (*May <u>not</u> be combined for consecutive hour blocks of exclusive use.)

## Reservation Procedures

Advance booking is limited to 12 months for groups staying 2 or more nights, 6 months for one night. A reservation is complete once the signed contract and an initial 10% deposit is received. 3 months before the event, a second deposit of 15% is due and final changes to lodging may be made without penalty. Final counts for meals and activities must be given no later than ten days prior to arrival, after this time meals may be added but not dropped; also, meeting room assignments will be made at this time. Please read the contract carefully. All deposits are non-refundable. Groups must supply insurance information at least 3 days prior to arrival. The final bill will be calculated at the time of the event based on the activities that actually took place and the number of people that attended. An estimate based on a group's projected numbers may be provided at any time, upon request. Full payment is expected on arrival, and any additional charges paid before departure; a 5% late fee may be charged for any balance remaining after departure.
